In addition, the service is operated at the GWDG istelf and is thus under the control of the GWDG compared to commercial cloud services such as Zoom. Any user with a valid account with the GWDG and a current web browser can use this service. For web browser use, simply access https://meet.gwdg.de/.For courses it is best to use the meeting plug-in in your Stud.IP event. This way the meeting room is not assigned to you personally, but to the event.
